The applications I used to create the medal were, Microsoft Paint, which was hard to use. I started off doing the back of my medal on this but it was really hard to do so I saved it and copied it into Microsoft PhotoDraw and again it was much easier to use then Microsoft Paint. The way I created the medal shape was using Microsoft Visio because this application show you the measurements and this was grate made it easier to keep the medal the right size.

I had to put the logo I designed on the front of the medal and an image on the back. The medal I had to design was foe the winner so I put gold on the front of the medal to fill the empty space.

T-shirt

I draw a t-shirt outline and then scanned it into the computer. I used Microsoft PhotoDraw to create the t-shirt. I made two designs and got feedback on both of them to see which one people liked the best. By doing this people I asked like bit from both t-shirts so I added both t-shirts together to create one, then got feedback from this one and they liked it.

The images on the t-shirt was my logo which I copied and pasted on and that was already made, the I created the text in Microsoft PhotoDraw and put it under the logo which looked really affective and I like it. I put footprints on the t-shirt to give the image of running, and I think that was achieved too. The footprints were made in Microsoft Paint and I pasted then into Microsoft PhotoDraw so I think I used layering on this t-shirt. Although the t-shirt was hard to do but I liked the challenge and it tuner out good.

I really enjoyed doing the gift bag because it was something different and I could make it myself and that was really fun to do. There was a lot to do with the gift bag like a 2D drawing 3D drawing of the gift bag, but I added in some extras like making the gift bag by had and putting the net of the gift bad was well.

The way I created my gift bag was I started off in Microsoft Paint doing the outline of the 2D and 3D gift bag then copied and pasted it into Microsoft PhotoDraw and added all the detail onto it, like the logo and the footprints. I also did a net of the gift bag showing the size and folds of the gift bag.
