I think that it stands out more now and I like it I think feedback is really good because it helps with making your work better.



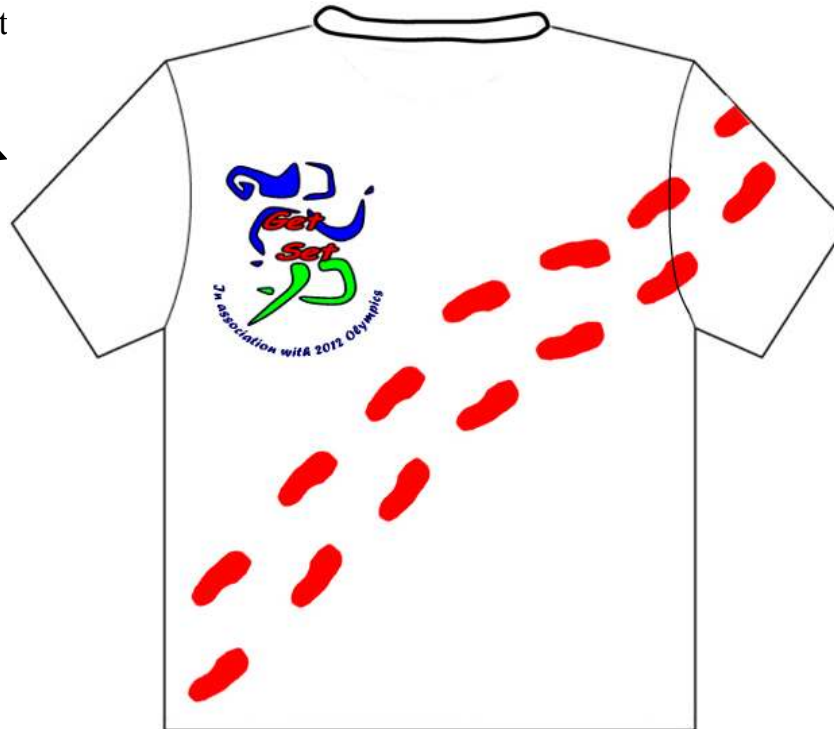
